Swachata Sarvekshan was organized by the N.S.S unit in collaboration with the B.N.C.M.C which was attended by the Deputy Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner and Additional Commissioner of B.N.C.M.C. A seminar on 'Adolescent health' was held by Dr. Supriya Arwari and a special lecture was held on 'Breast Cancer awareness' by Dr. Alia Rais.

I am also delighted to highlight the stories of many of our college students who achieved several prizes. In 2017-18, Our College actively participated in Youth festival at the university level competition held in S.P.N Doshi College, Ghatkoper, Mumbai, in which Mulla Sidra bagged the second prize in essay writing competition, Khan Mahenoor and and Mulla Sidra bagged third prize in Debate Competition.

Khan Mahenoor Asif of T.Y.B.Sc received 3rd prize in state level PowerPoint presentation held in G.M. Momin Women's College.

In 2017-18, Khan Mahenoor and Siddique Maria bagged first prize in Debate competition held in S.N.D.T. Mumbai. Our College won 3rd prize in the youth festival held in S.N.D.T. Mumbai, in which our students made us proud. Our students also participated in “Rupantaran”, which was conducted by Swayam Siddhi College, where in, Ansari Sidra and Khan Mahenoor bagged first prize in Debate competition and case study competition respectively. Our students were also among the top twenty in Tejaswini competition held at S.N.D.T, Mumbai.

At the Parvaz intercollegiate completion held by Kalsekar College, Kausa, Ansari Amina Arman Ali of T.Y.B.Sc Zoology won first position in Mehndi Competition. Mulla Sidra Ilyas bagged 1st position in Essay Competition, Chowdhari Afreen of S.Y.B.Sc bagged 1st position in badminton and Memon Sameena of T.Y.B.Sc Chemistry bagged 2nd position in badminton competition and Ansari Zaheda of S.Y.B.Sc bagged 2nd position in Chess.

Our college cultural committee organized an “Art fair” in which many students participated and was a learning experience for them as many activities were carried out like recipe contest, Card making, Bookmark, Mehendi Competition etc.

“Euphoria” our 3 days inter collegiate festival was held in the month of January 2018 where various colleges participated in activities like gift wrapping, recipe contest, instant make-over, Egg shell decoration, Mehendi etc. Altogether the faculty and students participated in the festival very

actively and enthusiastically. The “JavedFarid” rotating Trophy for the year 2017-18 was won by our College.

The Department of Sociology, organized a Seminar on “Nasha Mukti Abhiyan” on 8th February, 2018 an awareness campaign on Vyasn Mukht Abhiyan in Cooperation with Bhiwandi Police with an aim to stop drug addiction, which was a great benefit to the youngsters of our college. Women's Day was celebrated by spreading Awareness among our students. The IQAC Committee with collaboration with the N.S.S conducted a seminar on 'Adolescent Health' by Dr Supriya Arwari, a gynecologist who had an interactive session with the students. The seminar gave the students as opportunity to clear all their medical doubts in the session.

The ICC [Internal Complaint Committee] organized a seminar on 'sexual Harassment at Work place'. The ICC committee also organized a seminar on Sexual Harassment and awareness at Work place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act 2013) in which two consecutive sessions were conducted by the, I/C Principal Farid Oneza Tanveer and Darekar Heera [Asst Lecturer, Botany Department].

The Meal Management and Nutrition Department make the students learn to prepare innovative and nutritious food products, its various types of packaging and thus this activity serves as an income generating activity where they produce and sell different food products in the college premises. Every year our meal management and nutrition students organize a Food festival in the college campus in which all the students, teaching staff and non-teaching staff actively participate. This particular activity enhances the entrepreneurship skills of our students. The Meal Management and Nutrition Department conducted a state level seminar on “Holistic Nutrition for Healthy Body and Soul” on 13th September, 2018. Our Meal Management students bagged 1st prize at the intercollegiate 'Women entrepreneurship competition held in G.M. Momin Women's College.

Today I think it is fair to say that Aqsa has never been stronger, more confident or more committed to serving wider society. It is the dedication of our management, faculty, students, staff who made it possible with their undertakings. Apart from the academic year 2017-18 was another successful year during which the institute progressed towards expanding its existing activities and initiated new activities. Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

Introduction

In pursuance of its Action Plan for performance evaluation, assessment and accreditation and quality up-gradation of institutions of higher education, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore proposes that every accredited institution should establish an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) as a post-accreditation quality sustenance measure. Since quality enhancement is a continuous process, the IQAC will become a part of the institution's system and work towards realization of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance. The prime task of the IQAC is to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of institutions. For this, during the post-accreditation period, it will channelize all efforts and measures of the institution towards promoting its holistic academic excellence.

The guidelines provided in the following pages will guide and facilitate the institution in the creation and operation of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). The work of the IQAC is the first step towards internalization and institutionalization of quality enhancement initiatives. Its success depends upon the sense of belongingness and participation it can inculcate in all the constituents of the institution. It will not be yet another hierarchical structure or a record-keeping exercise in the institution. It will be a facilitative and participative voluntary system/unit/organ of the institution. It has the potential to become a vehicle for ushering in quality enhancement by working out planned interventionist strategies to remove deficiencies and enhance quality like the "QuJity Circles" in industries.

Aim and Objectives of IQAC

- To develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic action to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution.
- To promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices.

Strategies

- a) Ensuring timely, efficient and progressive performance of academic, administrative and financial tasks;
- b) The relevance and quality of academic and research programmes;
- c) Equitable access to and affordability of academic programmes for various sections of society;
- d) Optimization and integration of modern methods of teaching and learning;
- e) The credibility of evaluation procedure;
- f) Ensuring the adequacy, maintenance and proper allocation of support structure and services;
- g) Sharing of research findings and networking with other institutions in India and abroad.

Benefits

- a) Ensure heightened level of clarity and focus in institutional functioning towards quality enhancement;
- b) Ensure internalization of the quality culture;

Ensure enhancement and coordination among various activities of the institution and institutional iie all good practices;

- c) Provide a sound basis for decision-making to improve institutional functioning;
- d) Act as a dynamic system for quality changes in HEIs;
- e) Build an organized methodology of documentation and internal communication.

Functions of IQAC

- a) Development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for various academic and administrative activities of the institution;
- b) Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive to quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process;
- c) Arrangement for feedback response from students, parents and other stakeholders on quality-related institutional processes;
- d) Dissemination of information on various quality parameters of higher education;
- e) Organization of inter and intra institutional workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles;
- f) Documentation of the various programmes/activities leading to quality improvement;
- g) Acting as a nodal agency of the Institution for coordinating quality-related activities, including adoption and dissemination of best practices;
- h) Development and maintenance of institutional database through MIS for the purpose of maintaining /enhancing the institutional quality;
- i) Development of Quality Culture in the institution;
- j) Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of NAAC.

After that prize distribution ceremony was held the students were awarded with trophies , Medals and Certificates for their achievements .

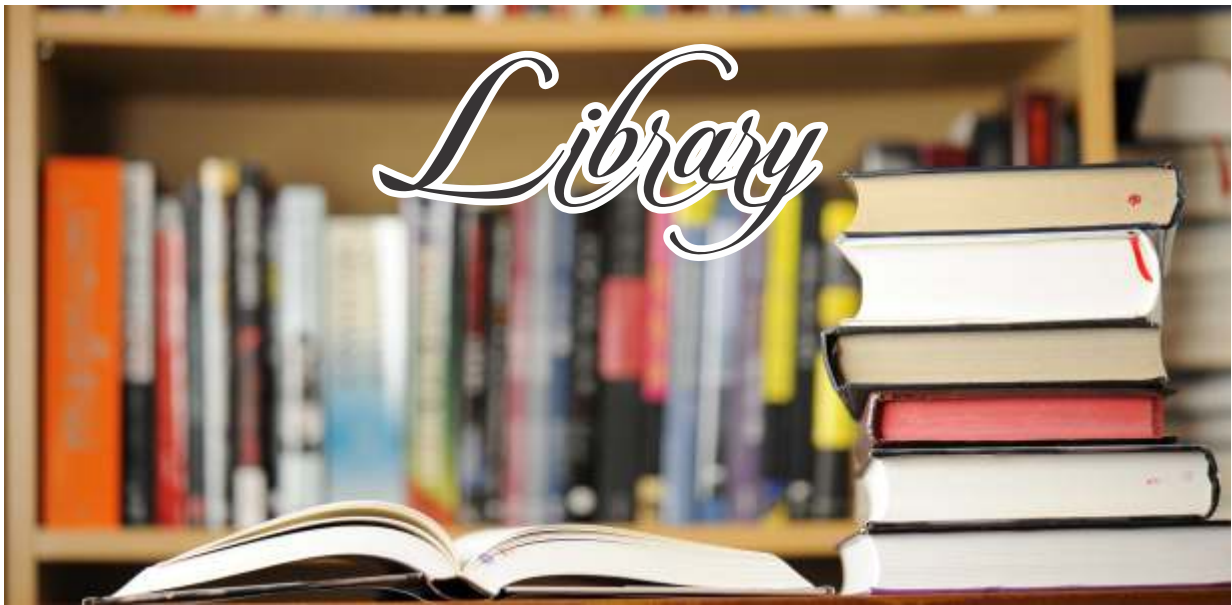
The Annual Day celebration started in the evening with the welcome address delivered by Principal she also read the annual report for a year 2017 – 2018 .

Among these Muhaddithun, Imam Bukhari is the most prominent. His book, *Sahih-al-Bukhari* is regarded as the most authentic book after the Quran. He collected a large number of *Ahadith* from different sources.

However, in his book, he collected only those hadith which he know were absolutely authentic. Once; a hadith was narrated to him through someone, and Imam wanted to verify it. Therefore, he went to a scholar who was known for both his piety and knowledge of the hadith.

When the house of the scholar, after a long journey, he saw the scholar trying to catch his escaped horse and return it to the stable. The horse wouldn't come back, so the scholar thought of a plan.

Benefits Of Kalonji Oil *(Black Seed Oil)*

Hazrat Abu Hurairah (R.T) narrtes that he near the prophet (S.A.W.S) saying that the black seed are good for treatment on each and every aliment. There is the treatment against each and every aliment except death. They are also called shoneez (Kalonji). Bhukhari, Muslim, Ibne-Maja Masand-i-Ahmed)

(1) Asthama, Cough, Allergy: In a cup of warm water, add a spoonful honey, half a spoon of kalonji oil to be mixed and drink it early in the morning when one is with empty stomach, as well as in the evening after meal from refrain from curd things. This treatment be kept continued for 40 days.

(2) Diabetes (Sugar): Take a cup of tea without milk and mix up in it half a spoon of kalonji oil and take it two times a day. One should refrain from oily foods and substances. If along with this treatment one is taking medicine against sugar also then it should get decreased. This treatment be carried on for 20 days. After wards, the patient be get checked. If the sugar is normal the treatment can be ended.

(3) Polio and Paralysis: For a grown up person take a cup of warm water, add to it a spoonful of honey and half a spoon of kalonji oil and get the person have it twice a day. For small children take two spoonful of milk, add three drops of kalonji oil and get it drink three times a day. This treatment be continued fr 40 days.

(4) Joint - Pain and Arthritis: Take a spoon ful of vinegar. Add half a spoon of kalonji oil and two spoonful of honey.

(5) Constipation, Gas, Stomach trouble, Ache and Pain: Take a spoonful of vinegar juice, add to it half a spoon of kalonji oil and give it to the person twice a day. The treatment is also useful against obesity. It causes the fat to melt and makes on thin this medicine be given twice a day, and one should be forced to refrain from all the substances that cause constipation and gas.



A new "Magic Bench" designed by Disney Research lets you interact with endearing animated characters. and no special glasses or headsets are required.

Instead, the complete environment .the seat, the sitter and the cartoon humanoid animals .is mirrored on a screen opposite the bench, making it possible for others to watch the scene unfold.

How does the illusion work?

A camera and sensor capture images and gather depth information about physical objects. the bench and the person that algorithms integrate with the 3D animations, the researchers wrote in a study. Meanwhile, haptic sensors built into the bench deliver vibrations that are synchronized to animated actions on the screen, creating the illusion that the animated figures are occupying real-world space next to the user

"Our mantra for this project was: hear a character coming, see them enter the space, and feel them sit next to you," Moshe Mahler, principal digital artist at Disney Research, said in a statement.

Augmented-reality overlays animated elements into views of the real world, typically by using special optical devices or mobile technology. However, one of its limitations is that its illusion can be glimpsed by only a single user. The Magic Bench allows groups of people to gather in a single environment and collectively participate in an augmented- reality experience, all at the same time, according to the study authors.

Sitting on the bench triggers the augmented-reality experience, introducing a character into the scene. In a video demonstration, a small cartoon donkey trots into view and kicks the bench, generating a sharp sound and making the seated person jump in surprise. Another test shows two people on the bench, reacting as they "feel" an animated rabbit leap up beside them and jump up and down. When a user passes his hand over the rabbit, a shadow moves across its head. as though it were occupying the same physical space as the person next to it.

Researchers used the real-colour camera and the depth and colour sensors in a Microsoft Kinect to capture the real-world scene of the Magic Bench and the person (or people) on it. Rebuilding them in 3D places the bench between a foreground and background, which can then be populated with whimsical characters. But the Disney engineers discovered that if the reconstructed 3D scene were viewed at an angle, missing data and a small difference in alignment between the camera and sensor created gaps in the image known as "depth shadows."

To eliminate these depth shadows, designers layered another element into the scene. A 2D background captured by the Kinect's RGB camera, which seamlessly aligned with the scene when viewed head-on, the study authors wrote. Once the "stage" is set, it's ready to be shared with animated co-stars from elephants offering up a glowing orb to a giraffe lending an umbrella during a sudden drizzle.

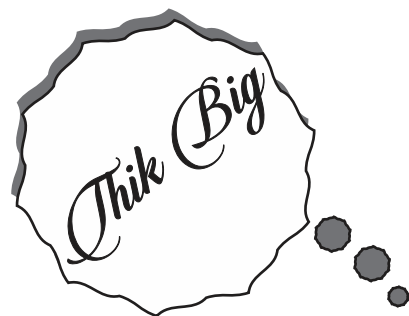

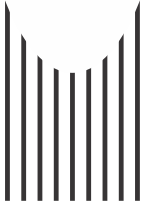

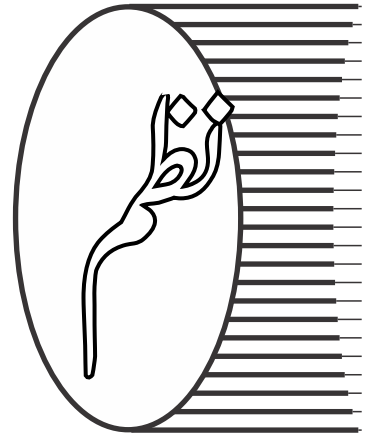
