Total 72 students attended the session; the programme was concluded by the summarizing of topics by Moallim Shaima and Darekar Heera, followed by National Anthem.

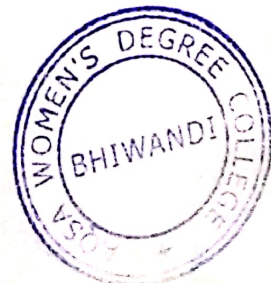

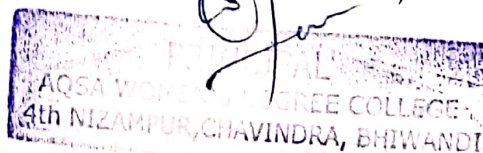
A One-Day Multi-Disciplinary National Seminar on “The World Environment Human and Society”

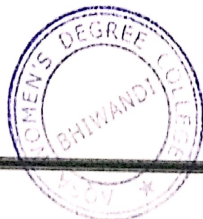
THE HEALTH OF WORKERS IN INFORMAL SECTORS

The world is quickly urbanizing and so is the incidence of poverty. The numbers of urban poor continue to grow in absolute terms and in relation to rural poverty, securing proper health conditions for worker is an important aspect of urban poverty alleviation. This survey analyses the health of the poorest Strata of urban workers in Bhiwandi city who bears the brunt of health problem.

The survey was conducted by class T.Y.B.A students from Department of Sociology based on their sociology paper "Industry and Society" under the supervision of departmental in charge Ms. Moallim Shalma. Students collected data based on questionnaire, from the various section of informal sector such as waste pickers, construction workers, complemented by summarized information on domestic workers, and street traders.

Study shows that there are various factors that affect their access to health care services such as poverty, the unpleasant attitude of some health workers towards clients, distance to service point, lack of skills staff at public health facilities and lack of knowledge affected access to health care services. The studies also reported cultural beliefs and practices also responsible for their health problems. Furthermore, most of the participants reported that they used the little money available to buy medicine anytime they fell ill. They added that they sometimes borrowed money from friends and relatives to take care of their medical bills.

These workers face the plethora of health problems noted by the students, leading to sickness, accidents, disability, premature retirement and premature death. Exposure to these numerous risks is high and the poor workers are the least protected. Large numbers of such workers do not have access to proper health care, protection against illness, accident or old age, and other types of social protection. Under such circumstances, injury or illness of one income earner in the household can lead to destitution, child labor or debt.

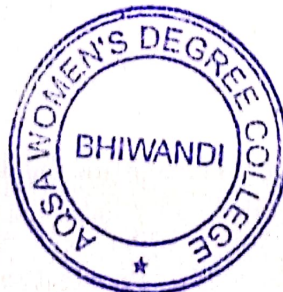
The gathering was concluded by question answer session, where students cleared their doubts about the topics, the program ended with vote of Thanks followed by the National Anthem.

The students spread the awareness with respect to symptoms, causes and remedies of cancer. The students clear their doubts by asking the questions to the presenters.

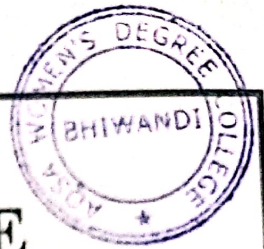

.. Sessions were organized around common practicals according to their syllabus like:



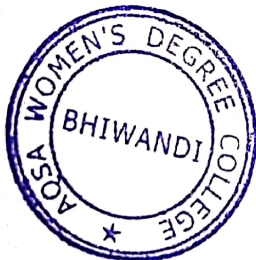
At 2.15 p.m. there was a lunch break for the guests as well as participants.

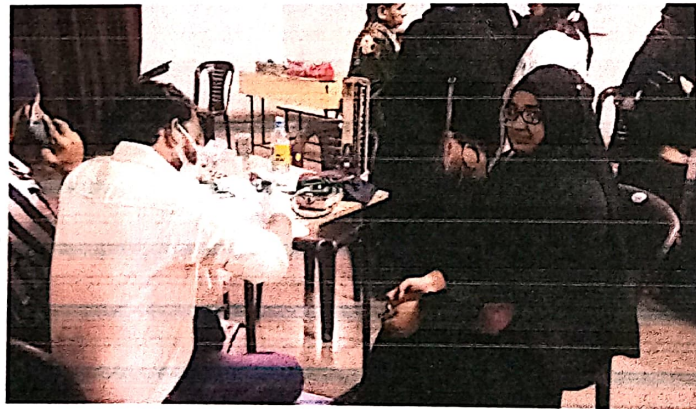
Volunteers of Aqsa College shared the posters of Blood Donation to various colleges of Bhiwandi and to the nearby residents.



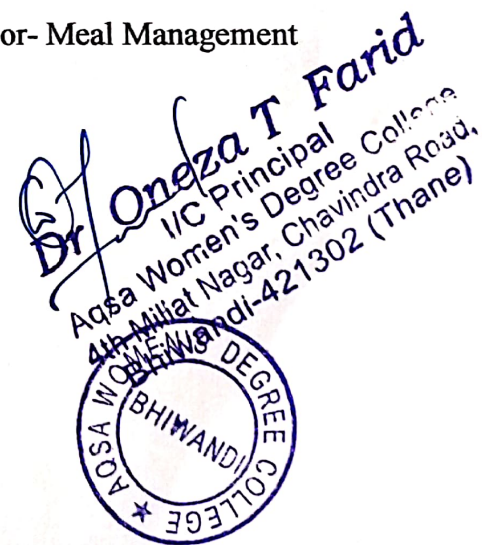

COMPOST PLANT PROJECT.

Report on Installation of Compost Plant

Composting is successful because it is a low cost and low infrastructure set-up and also produces compost, which is a marketable byproduct. In addition to making a positive contribution to agriculture, the sale of organic wastes reduces the amount of waste to be collected and disposed of by municipal authorities.

The NSS unit of Aqsa Women's Degree College organized an environment awareness drive in collaboration with the B.N.C.M.C. Aqsa Women's Degree College was the first college to install Compost plant in the college campus. During the special camp, team of Municipal Corporation and NSS together planned to install a compost plant in the college campus. The inauguration of the plant was done by the Deputy Commissioner Mrs. VandanaGudve and attended by Municipal Officer Mr. Gudvi, Corporator of Millat Nagar Mr. Imran Wali Mohammed Khan, Zonal Coordinator Mr. VinodZalte, Principal Ms. OnezaFarid and the staff of Aqsa Women's College.


Mrs. VandanaGudve addressed the students and explained the importance of compost plant in converting garbage into manure that can help reduce pollution and avoid accumulation of garbage.

The dry garbage from the Botanical garden, ground and kitchen waste of college canteen was collected and was used to prepare the temporary compost plant.

The team of NSS unit worked very hard for the completion of the task and their efforts were appreciated. The installation of the Compost plant was accomplished successfully.

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


Paper Presentation of T.Y B.Sc. (Zoology) Students in National Seminar

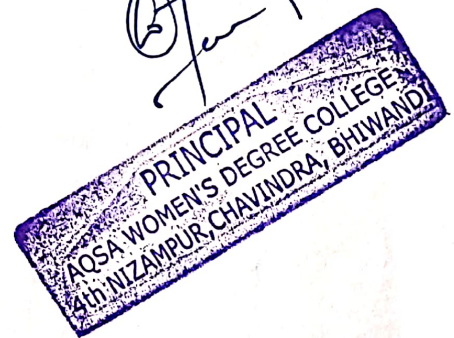

The Seminar was interesting and appreciated by the students. The feedback received was terrific and encouraging for all of us.

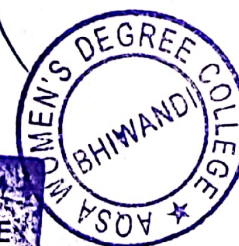
