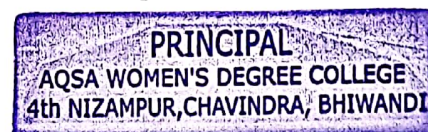



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REPORT: N.S.S Orientation for the year 2017-18


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REPORT: Independence Day Celebration-15th August 2017.

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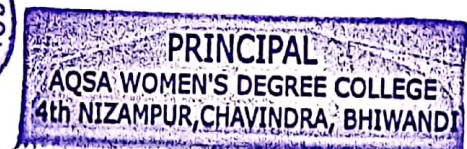
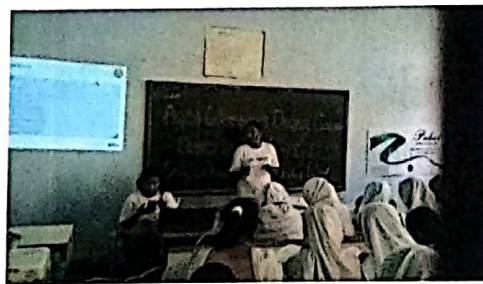
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Hepatitis Awareness programme – 8th September, 2017.

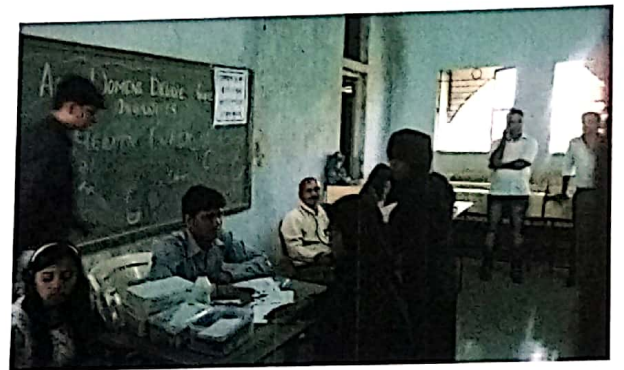

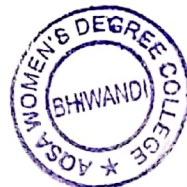



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ROAD SAFETY CAMPAIGN 'A TRIBUTE' - 27TH NOVEMBER.

A poster making competition on road safety was also arranged for the Volunteers. Three best posters were selected. Winners were awarded with Trophies and certificates.

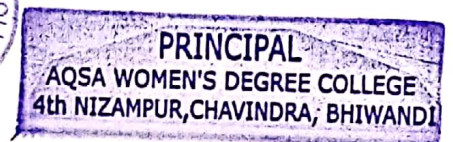


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'Anti- Terrorism Awareness Film Festival 2017'- 28th November.

The film was then presented before the team of Bhiwandi Police. The performance was appreciated by the audiences and our efforts were appreciated by all.

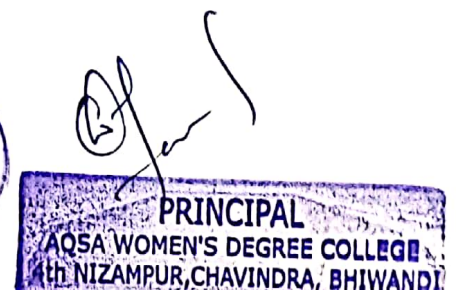


Skill Development Programme.

There were 125 students who attended the programme and almost half of them downloaded the application with the hope that will help us to make our Bhiwandi, a clean city very soon.




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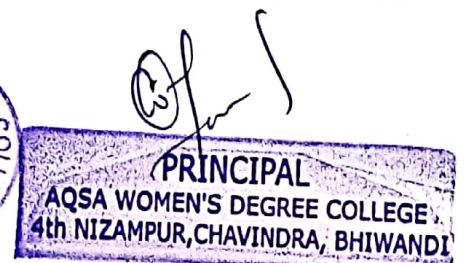
REPUBLIC DAY- 26TH JANUARY, 2018.

Aqsa Women's Degree College celebrated the National Festival with the NSS unit and it was indeed a very entertaining & enthusiastic event.

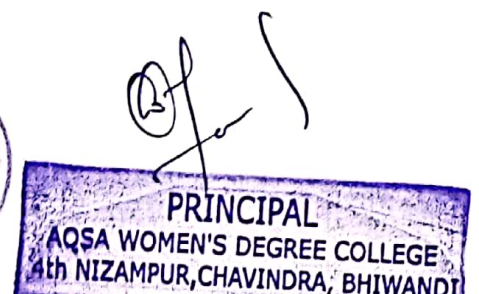


SEMINAR ON NASHA MUKTI – 08th February.

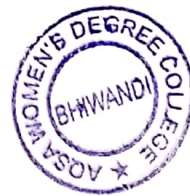

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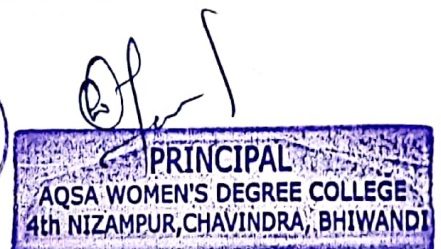

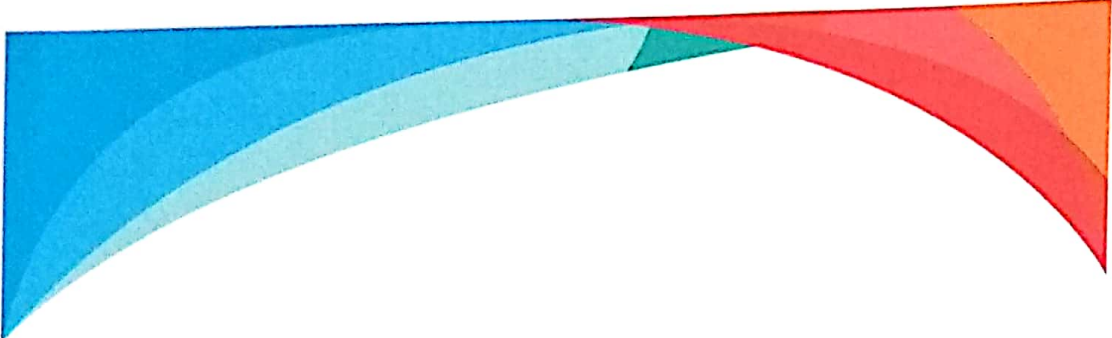
On account of Women's day- 8th March, Aqsa Women's Degree College organized seminar in two sessions.

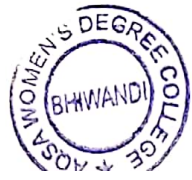
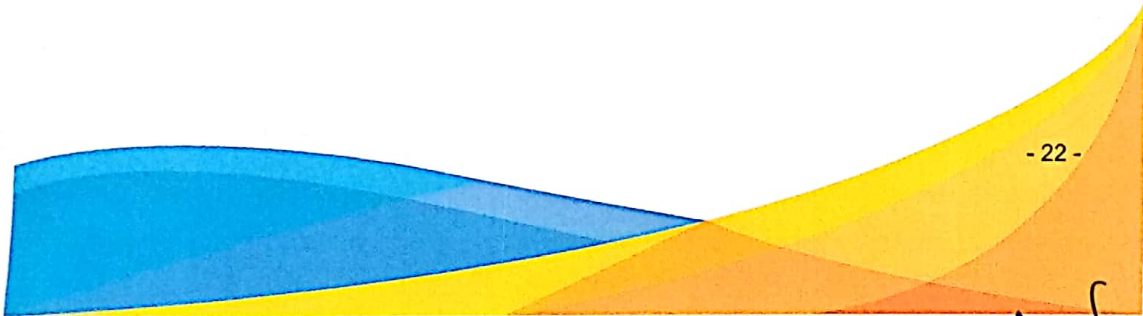

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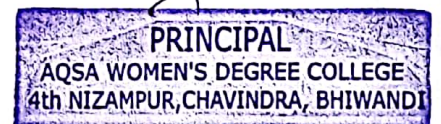
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Second day of Special Camp –12th December.

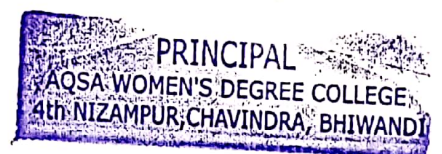
Milk adulteration testing was also conducted by the team of Consumer Guidance Society in which milk pouch was collected from different students and its purity was checked.

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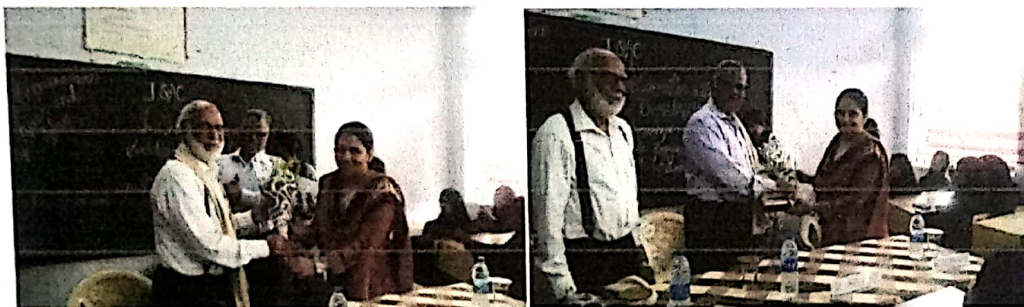


Report on Women Empowerment in Quran& Islam – 15th September, 2018.

The Day honours the date on which the constitution of India came into effect on 26 January 1950 replacing the Government of India (1935) as the governing document of India.

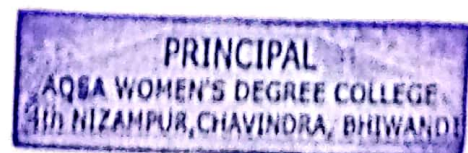

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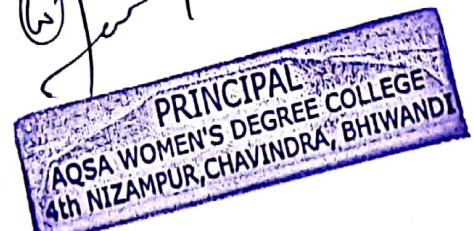
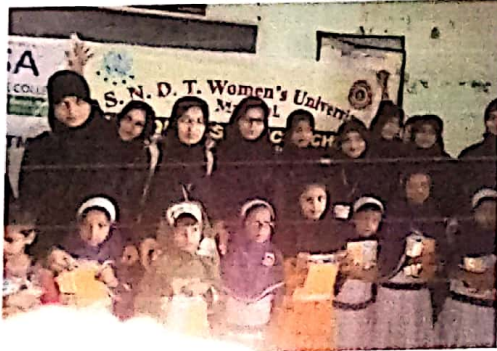
Field visit to Balwadi 2018-19

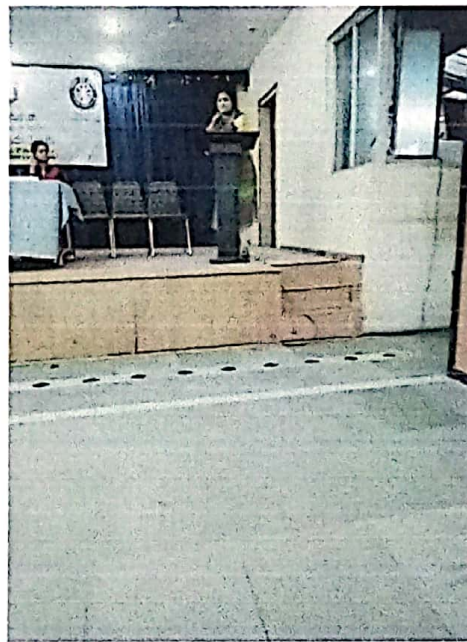


Yuvak Biiiradari's Yuva Bhushan- 08th December.

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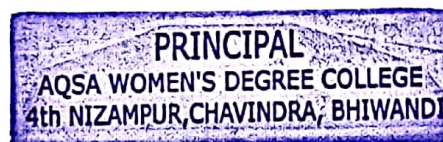
Science Day Celebration – 28th February.

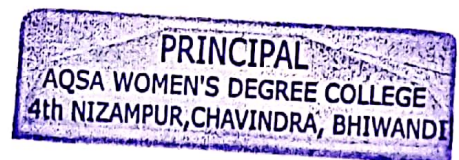
Mrs. VandanaGudve addressed the students and explained the importance of compost plant in converting garbage into manure that can help reduce pollution and avoid accumulation of garbage.

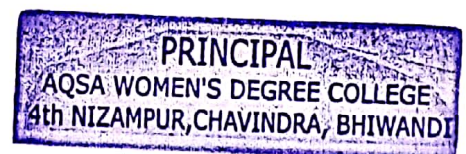

NSS inculcates the spirit of voluntary work among the students and teachers through sustained community interaction. It brings academic institutions closer to society. NSS Unit of Aqsa Women's Degree College of Arts, Commerce and Science started in the year 2011 with only 32 volunteers.


NSS Unit of Aqsa Women's Degree College for the year 2018-19 organized a special camp on following Theme: **Swachha Bharat Abhiyan, Skill Development Program and Women Empowerment** from 11th December – 17th December 2018. Inauguration of NSS special camp was done on Monday, 11th December, 2018 at 8.00 a.m in the morning. As per the schedule Yoga classes was conducted at Al-Noor School auditorium daily at 8 a.m – 9 a.m. The classes were held on meditation, nostril breathing, suryanamaskar, warm-up exercise, relaxation technique, weight balancing exercise and different asanas. After the breakfast of half an hour, the next session was divided into three parts: session-I seminar/ awareness campaign, after lunch, session – II cultural activity and session- III was Income generating courses.

The First day: 11th December- 9.00 a.m. of the special camp began with the yoga session. After the breakfast the next session started at 10.00 a.m. The NSS PO Shaikh Ayesha discussed the schedule of seven day camp with the volunteers. The work was distributed by dividing volunteers into seven groups. All the groups were allotted their respective duties during the seven days of camp. Volunteers completed the given task.




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After the lunch break, next session started at 2.00 pm with the income generating course. Al-Noor School students participated in a large number.

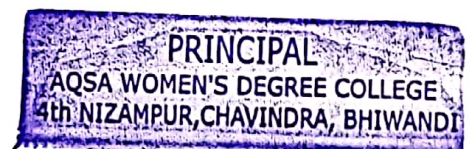

Third Day: 13th December- The camp initiated as per the schedule till the breakfast and continued with the next session at 10.30 a.m. A seminar on ‘**Women health and hygiene**’ was arranged for the Girls of adolescent age by Dr. Supriya Arwari, a gynecologist and obstetrician who gave an excellent presentation on how can health and hygiene be maintained from the adolescent age to the old age. Many of the students are unaware of the infections that occur during menstruation period which can result in harmful UTI and can result in death if not taken proper care. Volunteers were also provided with proper diet plan to avoid any deficiencies like anemia, calcium loss, protein deficiency, etc that is prone to happen in any age group of a women.



It was indeed enormous information that students could gather which can be useful not only to them but also to their family. Aqsa college is very grateful to Dr. Supriya for her efforts and these information could be lifesaving oneto many of us.

After this Free Hemoglobin checkup was done for women of all age group. Total 100 Hemoglobin tests were done. Females with low Hb level were advised for further treatment.

Next session started at 3.00 pm with the income generating course.

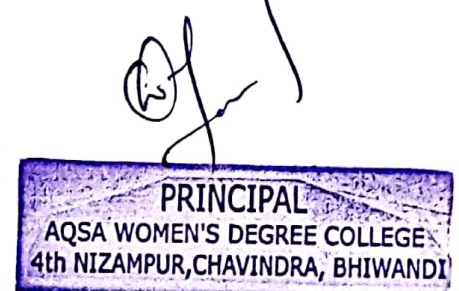

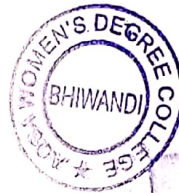

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The teachers and students were interviewed about the menu of the mid-day meal provided by the government. The students discussed about the available menus and changes that could be suggested.


Next session was income generating course for Al-Noor School students as well as open to all from nearby area. Students from third year of Aqsa College were selected for conducting the training.

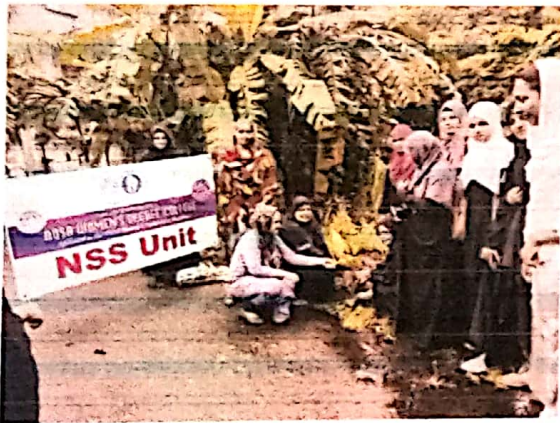
The NSS unit of Aqsa Women's Degree College conducted tree plantation campaign on occasion of Van Mohatsav.

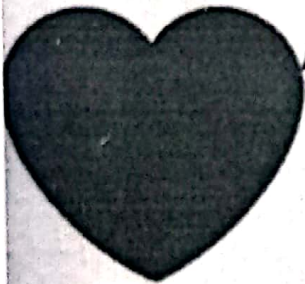

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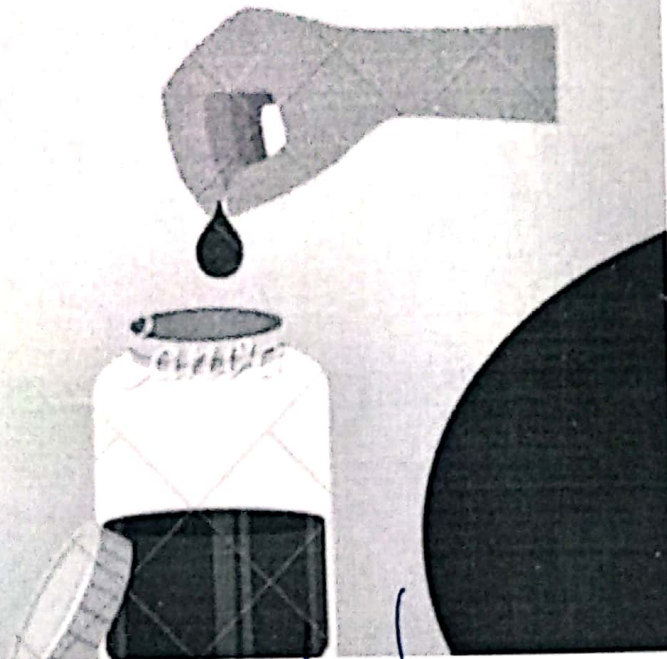

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Covid- 19 Vaccination Drive .

India began administration of COVID-19 vaccines on 16 January 2021. As of 3 April 2022, India has administered over 1.8 billion doses overall, including first, second and precautionary (booster) doses of the currently approved vaccines. In India, 91% of the eligible population (12+) has received at least one shot, and 77% of the eligible population (12+) is fully vaccinated.

Citizens above the age of 15 can book appointments through the COWIN platform or can do a Walk-In registration on site. All vaccine centres have registration desks, vaccine booths and observation rooms. Vaccine certificates can be downloaded digitally through the COWIN platform, or citizens can ask for a hard copy from vaccination centres. All government run vaccination centers provide free of cost vaccines, private centers do charge.



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First Phase, initial approvals, launch of vaccination programme

In September 2020, India's Health minister Harsh Vardhan stated that the country planned to approve and begin distribution of a vaccine by the first quarter of 2021.^[12] The first recipients were to be 30 million health workers directly dealing with COVID patients.

NSS Unit of Aqsa College in collaboration with B.N.C.M.C registered as Vaccine center thrice for the students and residents of Millatnagar. Overall around 500 individuals were immunized during the vaccination drive in Aqsa college.
