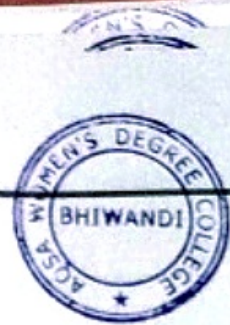



- Heckscher – Ohlin's Modern Theory of International Trade.

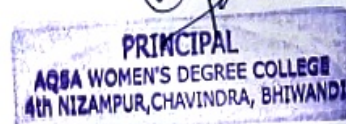

Guest Lecture On Current Trends in Life Sciences.

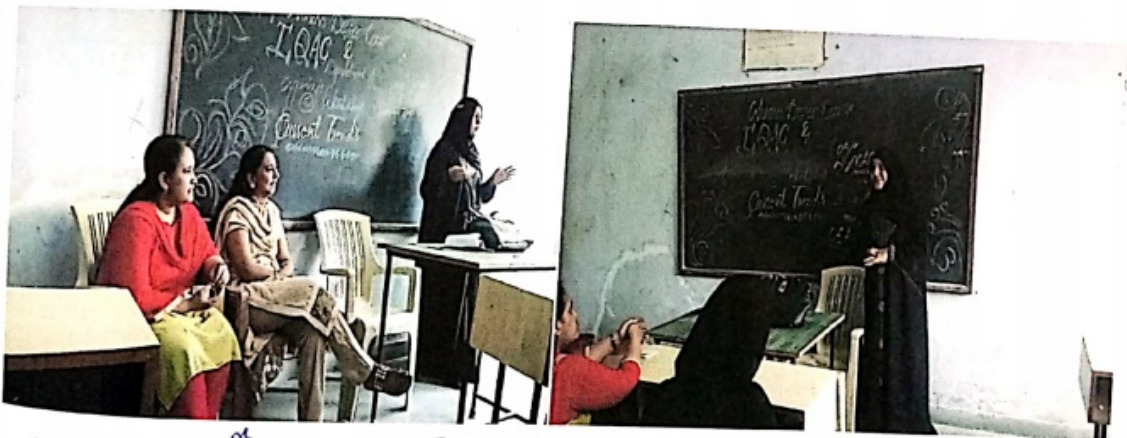
Aqsa Women's Degree College, IQAC and department of Zoology organizes guest lecture program for the Second year Students.

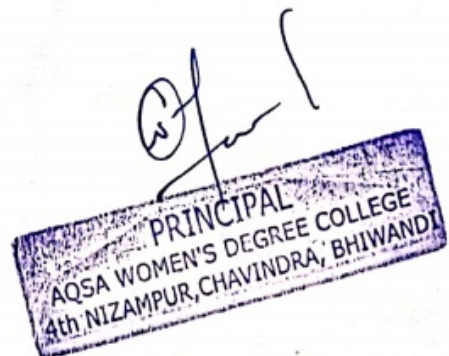
Along with Seminar Zoology department took an initiative of organizing an Poster presentation on Endangered and Exotics species to inculcate research habits among the undergraduates' students.

Equipments used for the collections of zooplanktons like plankton nets of different sizes, Sacchi disc, etc were shown to the students.

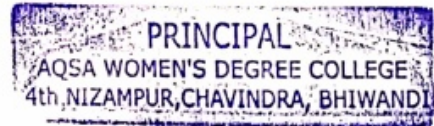
Various Arthropods, larva of Arthropods, aquatic insects, Nematodes were observed. List of organisms found was prepared by the students.

On 12TH September 2018, the .S.Y.B.A students of Arts faculty visited the Bhiwandi Nizampur Saheb Mahanagar Palika School no 66, 23. The visit to the school was arranged by the Meal management department of Aqsa Women's Degree College under the guidance of Asst. lecturer Don Sana Irfan. This activity was planned in collaboration with the N.S.S department in which free books with other accessories were distributed to the students. The students visited the Balwadi and the primary section of this school.
